



ACCEPTABLE AND FAIR USE POLICY

1. The Customer and Authorised Users must use (i) any software or services provided by Mintec (whether on a software as a service basis or under licence) only in conjunction with (ii) the data, information or content provided by Mintec through such software and services. Collectively the elements described at (i) and (ii) are referred to as "the Product" in this Acceptable and Fair Use Policy. The Customer and Authorised Users must use the Product in accordance with the terms of the agreement under which access is granted to the Product and must stop all use of the Product when that agreement ends.
2. Mintec may make changes to this Acceptable and Fair Use Policy to prevent unfair use or exploitation of the Product. All changes will be binding on the Customer and Authorised Users provided the change is commercially reasonable and does not have a material adverse impact on the Customer's or its Authorised Users' right to use the Product. If Mintec makes a change to the Acceptable and Fair Use Policy in accordance with this paragraph 2, Mintec will post the modification to the URL containing these terms and on such posting the change will be effective and apply to the Customer and its Authorised Users. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary, a change to this Acceptable and Fair Use Policy in accordance with this paragraph will not require a written document signed by Mintec and the Customer.
3. The usage limits that apply to an Authorised User will depend on how a User accesses the Product. If an Authorised User accesses the Product by logging into the Mintec website, then an Authorised User may not extract and download more than 100 individual data reports each day. If an Authorised User accesses the Product via an API, Excel add-in or other bulk download mechanism, then in total all Authorised Users accessing on behalf of the Customer may not make more than 10 calls to the Product per second and not make more than 10,000 calls to the Product in total each day.
4. The Customer and Authorised Users must not distribute or otherwise provide access to the data, information or content provided through the Product except as directly authorised in the agreement under which the Customer or Authorised User accesses the Product.
5. The Customer and Authorised Users must not use the Product to:
 - to violate, or encourage the violation of, the legal rights of others;
 - to engage in, promote or encourage illegal activity;
 - for any unlawful, invasive, infringing, defamatory or fraudulent purpose;
 - to intentionally distribute viruses, worms, Trojan horses, corrupted files, hoaxes, or other items of a destructive or deceptive nature;
 - to interfere with the use of the Product, or the equipment used to provide the Product, by customers, authorized resellers, or other authorized users; or
 - to disable, interfere with or circumvent any aspect of the Product.
